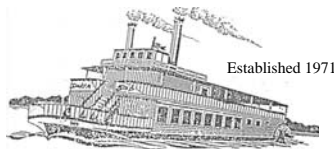

### Club News

**NEW AWARDS & POINT PROGRAM** – Starting September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005, the Delta 500 Club's Annual Awards and Points Program begins and continues until March 31, 2006. This program is designed to increase the participation of our members in the sport of bowling and the activities of the Delta 500 Club. Points are awarded for membership and the items listed below. This program is a tool for our club to determine which of our members will receive entries into the California State 500 Princess Tournament.

#### **Points can be earned for:**

- Membership Recruiting = 15 Points Each New Member
- Delta 500 Club Open Membership Meetings = 50 Points Each
- Local Association Membership Meetings = 25 Points Each
- Delta 500 Club Tournaments = 35 Points Each
- Other 500 Club Tournaments = 25 Points Each
- California State or National 500 Club Tournaments = 25 Points Each
- Local Level Association Tournaments = 20 Points Each
- California State Association Sponsored Tournaments = 25 Points Each
- USBC Annual National Tournaments = 25 Points Each
- Stockton Bowling Center Sponsored Tournaments = 5 Points Each
- Delta 500 Club Non-Bowling Activities or Events = 10 Points Per Event
- January Invitational Tournament Food Items: = up to 40 Points

**Vacant Position\*\***

Delta Board meetings are held on the first Thursday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at West Lane Bowl. They usually last about 1½ hours. Any Delta 500 Member or anyone wishing to help the Delta 500 Club as a volunteer is welcome to attend.

## AWARDS AND POINTS PROGRAM GENERAL RULES

1. In order to qualify for any prize category or an offer of a Princess Tournament entry, the member must have been awarded at least 150 awards points during the current program cycle.
2. Points cannot be transferred from one member to another. Points cannot be carried over from one annual program cycle to the next. Points can only be earned through the effort or participation of the individual member only. Points cannot be earned for a member through the efforts or participation of a family member or a friend of the member.
3. Category prizes are subject to change based upon the available number of entries that the Delta 500 Club is allocated for the Princess Tournament.
4. The program annual cycle time is subject to change based upon the date of the Princess Tournament and the established deadlines for the tournament entries.
5. Points cannot be awarded without proper verification that the points were earned.
6. Points will not be issued for any "All Events" tournament results.
7. Tournaments hosted and sponsored by bowling centers outside of the two Stockton bowling centers do not qualify for the award of points.
8. When a tournament has multiple squads and allows multiple entries, only one squad per tournament type will be allowed to earn points for the participation in the tournaments. This means that if there is a Singles, Doubles and Teams Tournaments, these will count as three separate tournaments and will earn points for participating in three separate tournaments. In order to properly award the correct number of points, the recap sheet, or sheets, must show which events the member actually bowled. The member will not automatically receive credit for multiple tournaments if the proof isn't there that the member bowled in multiple events.
9. Proper verification of tournament participation means that the member must supply a copy of the recap sheet, or sheets, and a copy of the complete entry form, (Blank is OK), for the tournament that shows who hosted the tournament and who was eligible to participate in the tournament. A copy of the entry form is not required if the form is listed in the Delta 500 Club website.
10. Points cannot be earned for working at a function or event unless the worker works the entire event and is thus unable to participate in the event. In this case, the worker will be awarded the same amount of points as a participant in the event. Any help and work that any member can provide for the success of an event is very much appreciated but cannot always be counted towards the award of any points. The need for workers is subject to the needs of the person in charge of the event.
11. Required verifications such as meeting attendance lists or tournament recap sheet copies must be submitted within the required time period or the points that would have been awarded, will not be awarded to the member.
12. Points may be awarded to a member by a majority vote of the Board of Directors if the member has performed a significant amount of hard work that was required in order for an event or activity to be successful. The actual amount of points awarded will correspond to the amount of work accomplished.

Think of a food item that you would like to bring to the Invitational Tournament to be held on January 29th. Those members that are present at the October meeting will get first choice.
