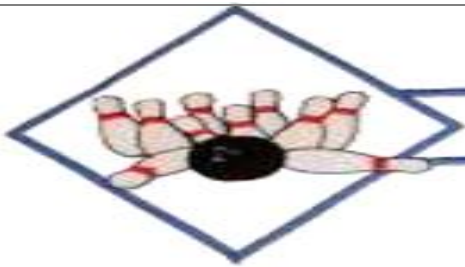


It's Time to Pay your Membership Dues
