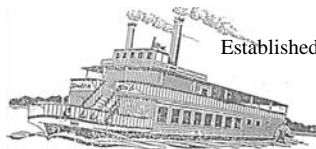

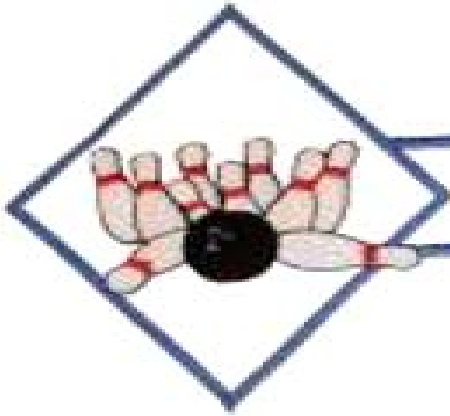
CASINO BUS TRIP

AWARDS & POINTS PROGRAM

Delta's Awards and Points program was started last September to increase participation from our members and to help determine which club representatives we would send to the State 500 Club Princess Tournament. This program seemed to have a rocky start but had a big finish with the Stockton City Tournament in March.

From our current 101 members, 62 members had over 100 points, 37 had over 150, 25 had over 200, 8 were over 300, 1 was over 400 and 1 was over 500 points. Next year should be a very interesting year. We have some new members that should give this year's top winners a run for their money. Over 1/2 of these new members earned 100 points or more in the last 3 months of the program. This program awards the top 15 members who have the highest amount of points earned. Below is a list of last year's winners.

Please remember that if you bowl in any tournament that is not put on by the Delta 500 Club, you need to send us either a copy of the results that showed you bowled or a copy of your re-cap from the tournament. Someone just saying they saw you bowl does not count. Be sure to get copies of your recaps from the state and or national tournaments (25 points each event, except all-event category), and any other tournament that you bowled, (this includes those from the local centers, other 500 clubs or other local associations and national and state 500 club tournaments). If you are not sure if the tournament you participated in qualifies for points, turn it in anyway. Please be sure that the recap or the results sheet has the name of the tournament and the date you participated.

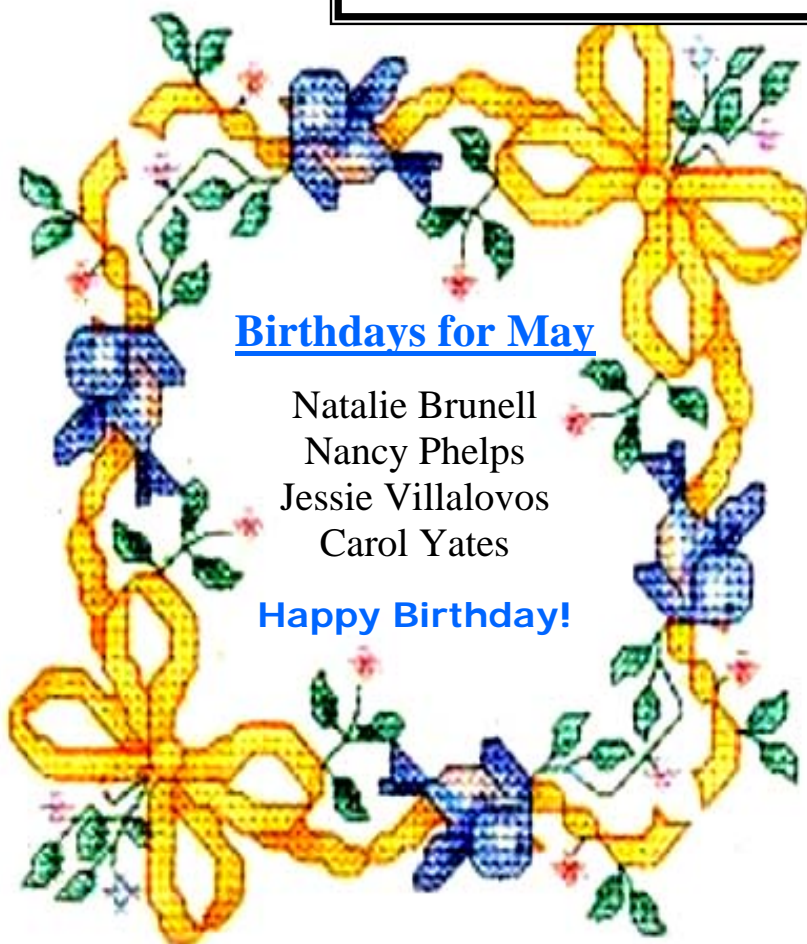
