Saturday, September 30th

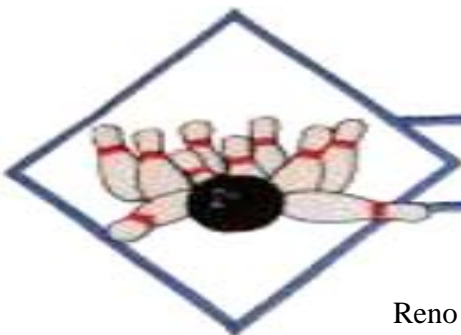
