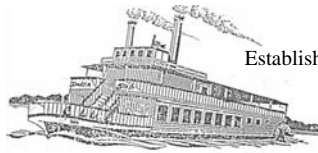

AWARDS & POINTS PROGRAM

The Delta 500 Club's Annual Awards and Points Program starts each year on April 1st and continues until March 31st of the following year. This program is designed to increase the participation of our members in the sport of bowling and the activities of the Delta 500 Club. Points are awarded for membership and the items listed below. This program is a tool for our club to determine which of our members will receive free entries into the California State 500 Princess Tournament and reward the top 15 members with a small token of our appreciation for their participation.

Be sure to get copies of your recaps from State or National Association Tournaments (25 points each event, except all-event category), and any other tournament that you have bowled recently, turned in as soon as possible so that these can be included in this year's Awards & Points Program. If you are not sure if the tournament you participated in qualifies, turn it in anyway. Please be sure that the recap has the name of the tournament and the date you participated. The winners from this program are announced at our Spring Open Membership Meeting.

NOTE: While bowling in the Women's State and National Championship Tournaments, please join the State and National 500 Club's (if not already a member) and participate in their special 500 club tournaments. (Turn in recaps, each worth 25 points – one recap per Club Event)

Points can be earned for:

- Membership Recruiting = 15 Points For Each New Member Recruited
- Delta 500 Club Open Membership Meetings = 50 Points Each
- Local Association Membership Meetings = 25 Points Each
- Delta 500 Club Tournaments = 35 Points Each
- Other 500 Club Tournaments = 25 Points Each
- California State or National 500 Club Tournaments = 25 Points Each
- Local Level Association Tournaments = 20 Points Each
- California State Association Sponsored Tournaments = 25 Points Each
- USBC Annual National Tournaments = 25 Points Each
- Stockton Bowling Center Sponsored Tournaments = 5 Points Each
- Delta 500 Club Non-Bowling Activities or Events = 10 Points Per Event
- January Invitational Tournament Food Items: = up to 40 Points

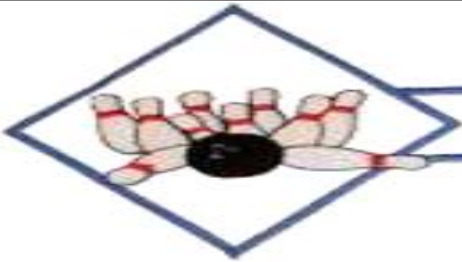

SPECIAL BUS TRIP UPDATE

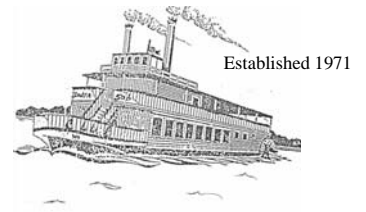

PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES

The Delta 500 Club sponsors various charitable projects each year. We raise money to send to these projects through tournament fees, raffles and other forms of solicitation. These projects include the BVL, the Bowl for a Cure Program, and our own Angle Wings Projects. If anyone wishes to make a donation to any of these projects, you can do so at any of our tournaments or events, or just leave it in the Correspondence boxes with a note as to where the donations are intended.



The Bowlers to Veterans Link is a national nonprofit charitable organization, which raises money to fund a variety of recreational equipment and therapeutic supplies for America's veterans. Last year the Delta 500 Club has raised \$506.00 for this organization through tournaments, raffles, and donations. This year, we hope to increase this donation for the veterans.

BOWL FOR A CURE

Breast cancer is the leading cause of death among women aged 40-59. Each year, USBC sponsors Bowl for the Cure®, a breast cancer awareness and fundraising initiative to benefit the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation. The Delta 500 Club has raised the funds for this program all year long through raffles, tournaments and donations. Last year we donated \$306.00 for this organization.



THE DELTA 500 CLUB ANGEL WINGS PROJECT



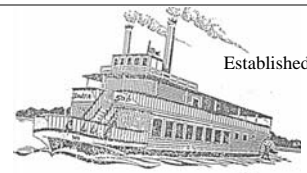
The Angel Wings Project is a Delta 500 Club activity and is not directly related to any other organization. Each year, the club generates money that is donated, in the form of useable goods, to local non-profit organizations that support the needs of the community. Each year we try to collect donations to purchase gifts and food items for a needy local family. Throughout the year we collect small personal items and used clothing to help support a local shelter. The shelter that we are currently helping is called "Second Chance" located on Pershing Ave. This program is also used to help during catastrophes and national disasters.

The Board of Directors determines who will receive the Angel Wings funding, each year. The reason for this is that the destination of these funds and all funds collected though a Non-Profit organization MUST meet certain requirements and it is the Board's responsibility to verify that our efforts meet these requirements.

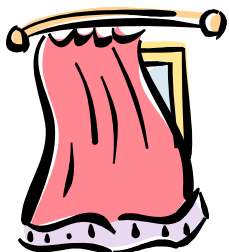

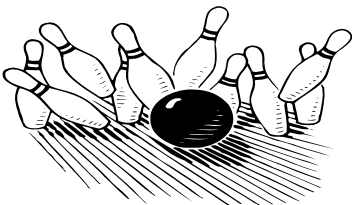
