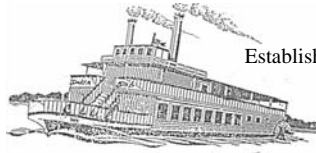

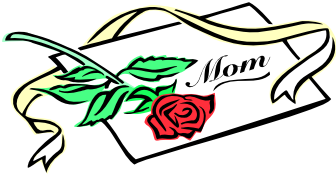

Points & Awards Program

The Delta 500 Club's Points and Awards Program was started in September 2005 to increase participation from our members in the sport of bowling and the activities of the Delta 500 Club. It is also used to help determine which club representatives that we would send to the State 500 Club Princess Tournament.

Points are awarded to the members for their Membership, Membership Recruiting, Participating in Tournaments, attending Delta 500 Club and local association meetings and for participating in the events of some other organizations.

This annual program cycle starts each year on April 1st and ends on March 31st.

From our current 110 members, 59 members had over 100 points, 33 had over 200, 22 were over 300, 14 were over 400 and 8 were over 500 points. Next year should be a very interesting year. This program awards the top 15 members who have the highest amount of points earned. Below is a list of what they win.

- **CATEGORY 1** - The absolute top points winner receives a paid entry into the California State 500 Club Princess Tournament, a free Delta 500 Club membership for the next year, five dollars in California Lottery Scratcher tickets and a bowling vest bowling pin, of her choice, available from the Delta 500 Club.
- **CATEGORY 2** - The 2nd through 8th place point's earners have first choice of a paid entry into the California State 500 Club Princess Tournament. . If any winner in this category declines to participate, or is not qualified to participate in this tournament, that winner will instead receive their next year's Delta 500 Club membership free.
- **CATEGORY 3** - The 9th and 10th place point's earners will receive their next year's Delta 500 Club membership free.
- **CATEGORY 4** - The 11th and 12th place point's winners each received \$5.00 worth of California Lottery Scratcher tickets.
- **CATEGORY 5** - The 13th through 15th place point's winners each received a certificate for a bowling vest bowling pin of their choice available from the Delta 500 Club.

Please remember that if you bowl in any tournament that is not put on by the Delta 500 Club, you need to send us either a copy of the results that showed you bowled or a copy of your re-cap from the tournament. Someone just saying they saw you bowl does not count. Be sure to get copies of your recaps from the State and or National Tournaments (25 points each event, except all-event category), and any other tournament that you bowled, (this includes those from the local centers, other 500 clubs or other local associations and National and State 500 Club Tournaments). If you are not sure if the tournament you participated in qualifies for points, turn it in anyway. Please be sure that the recap or the results sheet has the name of the tournament and the date you participated.

New Day for Delta's Board Meetings

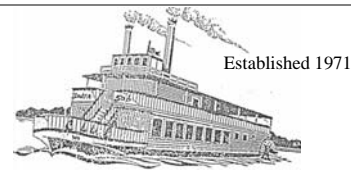
